# Generation 1 Thomas Adler (before c. 1670-1724)

American and World Events during the Life of Thomas Adler:

- 1. 1664 English seize New Amsterdam from the Dutch and name it New York City.

#### Thomas Adler

Born c. 1670 in Germany in an unknown village

Married 9 January 1685 in Viernheim (Hessen) Germany

"On January 9 1685 Thomas Adeler a single man and Magdalena Köhler widow of Michael Schorn were married. Witnesses were Johann Michael Leonard Oppell and Franz Bägel etc."

Died 23 November 1724 in Viernheim (Hessen) Germany

"November 23 died Thomas Adler, Alderman, as a result of nerve contractions having been bedridden for ten years and restored by Holy Viaticum (Eucharist) and fortified by Extreme Unction before the onset of cramps. Age 64 years."

Notes: the Familienbuch for Viernheim posits this man's birth in the mid 1640s. However, his death record above states he is 64. It also posits his place of birth as Viernheim. However, no Adler appears in the birth records which began in the 1620s until the birth of Thomas' first son Friedrich in 1686. Likewise, there is no Adler marriage before his marriage and no Adler death until he begins his family. This means that all the Adlers in Viernheim descended from this man.
