Franz Adler

Born 13 February 1725 in Viernheim (Hessen) Germany

“On the 13th of February 1725 the legitimate son of Friedrich Adler, citizen, and his wife Anna Margaretha was baptized Franz. The levans (godparent) was Franz Nagel, a citizen.”

Married 29 April 1749 in Viernheim (Hessen) Germany

“On the 29th of April 1749 the upstanding bachelor Franz Adler entered into matrimony with the modest virgin Anna Maria Kohler in the presence of the witnesses Georg Adler and Alexander Killian, both of this place.”

Died 8 February 1785 in Viernheim (Hessen) Germany

“On the 8th of february 1785 Franz Adler died well-provided for (i.e. he received the last sacraments). He was 58 years old.”

Anna Maria Kohler

Born 14 May 1731 in Viernheim (Hessen) Germany

“ On the 14th of May 1731 the legitimate daughter of Alexander Kohler, citizen and his wife Anna Maria (Englert) was baptized Anna. The godparents were Anna the wife of Georg Winckler of this place and Magdalena Plat the wife of Georg Plat.”
